我满怀感恩之心，为2025美华青少年交响乐团新年专场音乐会表达我的心声。

美华青少年交响乐团 (AmeriCal Youth Symphony)在积极筹备两年后，于2017年2月21日正式成立，由我和《华人》杂志创刊人马平老师共同创建，我担任常任首席指挥和艺术总监，二位青年音乐家Willie Gao 和Tony Gonzalez担任指挥。音乐家余野、张淑香、沈桑、王婷婷担任乐团技术指导。乐团还设有以陈翔凌、何易平、陈虞为核心的强大的家长后援会和优秀的学生会。成立八年来，乐团健康稳健地持续发展，在编小音乐家已超过七十人。八年来，乐团致力于为美国华裔和其他族裔青少年音乐家提供展示音乐才华、打造和促进中西文化交流的平台，在众多文艺和社区活动中展现风采，排演了超过三十多部交响曲，大小演出四十多场，获得华洋社区的肯定。

在过去的2024年，我们成功举办了2024年交响乐专场新年音乐会，2024圣地亚哥华人华侨中秋晚会暨第七届美国华人青少年艺术节，先后参加了Ronald McDonald House Charities of San Diego Concert、Qualcomm Q Kids Day Concert、Rancho Bernardo Branch Library Concert等的大型演出，多次室内小型演出。每次演出都极为成功，家长们、孩子们的队伍颇为壮观，大家团结协作，圆满成功地完成演出任务。

2024年金秋十月，我们荣幸地聘请到音乐家、打击乐演奏家 Tony Gonzalez，这位出自美国朱丽亚音乐学院七年本硕毕业的高材生，加入我们的乐团大家庭，担任乐团打击乐专业指导和乐团指挥，我十分期待乐团水准将会再次大大提升。

乐团的青年指挥Willer gao已担任助理指挥乐团多年，他曾做为低音提琴手在2017年2月加入乐团，成为“开团四君子”之一。大学毕业后又回到乐团指挥，从乐团起始至今已经八年。他兢兢

业业，勤勤恳恳，为乐团的稳定和发展作出了极大的奉献。今年秋季，他将入读著名美国医学院，我期待他常常回团看看。

2026年的新年音乐会我将好好的介绍乐团的名校毕业生、科学/艺术获奖生、及芭蕾舞主角等优秀团员。

2025年的新年音乐会，乐团将演奏九首大型交响乐曲，同时，我们将有阵容庞大的打击乐队、小荷才露尖尖角的四大低音提琴手，和华人之友小主持人俱乐部、兴竖舞校的芭蕾舞友情助演，将是一场音乐盛宴！

美国华人青少年交响乐团如虎添翼 常任指挥扬声博士谈青年指挥 Tony



近期,《华人新一代》记者采访了扬声指挥,请他向读者介绍这位新来的年轻指挥Tony。

记者:扬声博士,祝贺乐团来了一位青年指挥,又增加了新生力量。请向我们介绍一下Tony指挥的相关背景。

扬声:非常高兴能在这里介绍Tony指挥, Tony的正

记者:请问Tony是什么时候加入乐团的?当时乐团的情况怎么样?

扬声：八年前乐团刚开始的时候，曾经有一位定音鼓打得很不错的孩子，名叫David。他上大学后，乐团一直找不到定音鼓手，成为乐团的一大弱项。我本人没学过打击乐，无法教导孩子们的打击乐，甚至在去年的新年音乐会，我临时将我的一位非常好的小提琴手Daniel 拉上去打定音鼓。后来陆续招进了几个打击乐手，但我无法教导他们，直到去年十月，Tony老师的到来，乐团才开始了打击乐的真正训练和排练。

记者：你认为Tony加入后为乐团带来什么样的进展？

扬声：我对Tony老师的到来感到无比的欣喜！你看，才三个月的时间，打击乐声部就发展壮大起来。首先我们购买了大量的打击乐器材和乐器，同时招兵买马，组建队伍。Tony老师认真教导，干劲十足，一个十人的打击乐队已经初具规模。今天我们要看到的《悦闹花城》就让人耳目一新，打击乐声声振耳，分外喜庆！未来我们还将排练更多的打击乐作品，与社区众多观众分享。

记者：你认为Tony的指挥特点是什么？有哪些与你不同的风格？

扬声：Tony老师才刚刚开始在我们乐团指挥第一首打击乐作品，还不能从风格上去评说，但我从他的一些文字和视频中看到，他是一位非常有趣、充满激情、一丝不苟的音乐家。他在拉美、北美和亚洲等地的丰富经历，成就了他的音乐功底。可以说，他是一位音乐技术娴熟、音乐

修养全面的艺术家。

记者：您作为新中国文革后第一批指挥专业的大学生，你的指挥经历与毕业于美国茱莉亚音乐学院的毕业生肯定有很大的差别，不过我更想知道你们的共同点是什么？

扬声：国内的和欧美的音乐院校的指挥专业教学都是一个路子，传统、古典、严谨，没有什么差异。我的指挥老师朱步熹教授比较细腻、优雅，我也一样，干了一辈子从来没有“疯”过。Tony老师年轻体魄强健，又是打击乐专业毕业，他的指挥比较“疯”。

记者：截止目前，你最欣赏Tony的地方是什么？

扬声：勤奋、智慧、友好。

记者：您寄希望于Tony在乐团的发展进程中起到什么作用？

扬声：一个乐团的起步乃至兴旺与衰落，虽有多种因素所造成，但毫无疑问，一个优秀的指挥起着举足轻重的作用，是一个乐团的灵魂人物，可以影响和成就乐团。随着Willie指挥即将入读医学院，我也因为做过心脏手术，体力不如以前。在这种情况下，Tony来到我们乐团。任重道远，盼望年轻的Tony老师的到来，让我们美华乐团更加稳健向上，更加兴旺发达。

Anthony d'Conde's introduction



Born in L.A., studied early music education from his father Pepe Conde, a renowned Mexican tenor learning singing, guitar and piano, while frequently attending concerts at the Hollywood Bowl. Anthony went on to be accepted at age 8 into the Escuela de Bellas Artes' (Fine Arts Conservatory) adult percussion professional Diploma program in Mexico. Soon after, he started touring with the conservatory chorus, chamber ensembles and symphony orchestra as singer, percussionist and timpanist, as well as also becoming the lead drum set player for the conservatory's jazz band at age 10. During his time in Mexico, Anthony studied percussion with professor Mariano Hernandez.

Anthony then performed first time as soloist with the State of Mexico Symphony Orchestra at age 11 getting his first pay check in life which he gave to mom as a gift. Coming back to Los Angeles and San Diego, Anthony studied percussion from Tatsuo Sasaki (San Diego Symphony timpanist) and Mitchell Peters (LA Philharmonic percussionist and timpanist). During his high school years, Anthony performed solo, chamber and orchestra concerts around North America, Latin America and Europe. During 12th grade, Anthony performed 6 education and regular season concerts as marimba soloist with San Diego Symphony as a Young Artist's Concerto Competition winner performing "Paul Creston's Marimba Concerto." Anthony then ventured to the vibrant New York city where he lived for 6

years during his university studies. He was blessed to study percussion and timpani from Daniel Druckman (NY Philharmonic percussionist) and Roland Kohloff (NY Philharmonic timpanist). He also studied conducting from professors Otto-Werner Mueller, Jeffrey Milarsky, Miguel Harth-Bedoya and Rossen Milanov; and took composition and music technology classes from John Corigliano, Eric Ewasen, Andrew Thomas, Manuel Sosa and Robert Beaser. While in New York, Anthony performed with ensembles like National Repertory Orchestra, Academy of the West Symphony, Bowdoin Orchestra, Juilliard Symphony, New Juilliard Ensemble, Brooklyn Symphony, Hoboken Opera Orchestra, as well as in playing some Broadway and Off-Broadway shows. Anthony has performed at Lincoln Center, Carnegie Hall, Disney Hall, Concertgebouw, Musikverein, Teatro de Bellas Artes, as well as countless other famous theatres around the globe.

A month after graduating university, he was hired by the Guangzhou Symphony Orchestra and relocated to China. Functioning as Principal Percussionist and Principal Timpanist, he became the youngest musician in the world to be given two principal roles in a professional orchestra. While living in China, he performed with famous orchestras like: Hong Kong Philharmonic, Macau Chamber Orchestra, Guangzhou Symphony, Shanghai Radio Symphony and China Philharmonic; as well as countless youth orches-

tras, bands and ensembles. Anthony was also professor and conductor at Xinghai Conservatory, Guangzhou University, Sun Yat-sen University, Guangdong University of Foreign Studies, Guangzhou Normal University, Guangdong University of Technology and Guangzhou Opera House.

Though out his life he has performed almost every major stage musical show and has premiered 68 works, some which are his own compositions, varying from solo percussion, percussion ensemble, stage musical, chamber music and orchestra.

30 years of teaching, conducting and playing percussion around North America, Latin America, Europe, Asia, Australia, Africa and Middle East, can show not only with his deep love for Western Classical, Chinese, Latin and any World music; but also his love and commitment to education and with the way his professional students have turned out to reach admirable professional achievements throughout the years. His young music students have been accepted to renowned conservatories and universities like: Juilliard, Curtis, Manhattan, Eastman, John Hopkins, Boston Conservatory, Berklee College, NYU, Yale, McGill, Geneva, Paris, Berlin, Royal and Sydney to name a few.

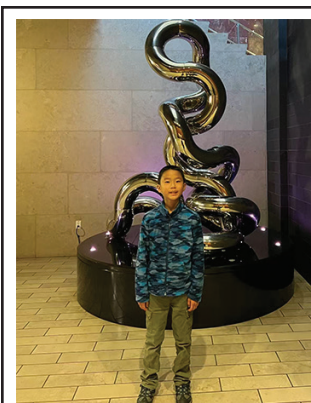
